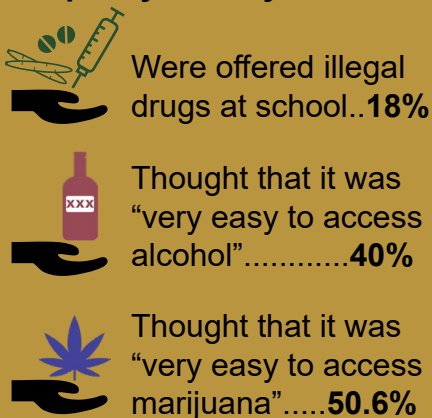


NH Youth in Recovery Face Many Risk Factors for Relapse...

Creating Connections NH is building a community of recovery supports for youth who experience Substance Use Disorder (SUD) or SUD with co-occurring mental health disorders. The Creating Connections NH treatment and recovery model emphasizes evidence-based practices, a harm reduction approach, and access to Peer Recovery Supports throughout a young person's journey to wellness.



Alternative Peer Groups (APGs) offer young people a chance to connect with peers in an environment that is safe, substance-free, and recovery-focused.

- APG Facilitators are trained recovery support professionals
- Youth help choose fun group activities that match their interests
- Youths' physical and emotional safety and privacy are a priority
- Opportunities for family/caregiver involvement
